Patron Health and Safety Procedures

The safety of our patrons, staff, performing artists and other guests is a primary concern for Lyric Opera of Kansas City. To create and maintain a safe environment for all individuals, we are implementing additional safety protocols and sanitation procedures. A listing of these initiatives is listed below:

- Adding no contact, wall mount hand sanitizer stations
- Supplying wipes and sanitizing solution
- Spraying buildings regularly with a Clorox 360 disinfectant machine
- Regularly cleaning high touch areas
- Placing signage throughout all buildings detailing required mask usage, social distancing of 6 feet, and reduced occupancy in certain areas

Self-Health Check: Review the list below and if you are experiencing any of these symptoms, please purchase [digital access to this program](#) instead of the live performance:

- You have been diagnosed with COVID-19 or have been in contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days (including the period of time which is 48 hours before the individual became symptomatic)
- You have a temperature at or above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit
- You are not feeling well
- You are exhibiting symptoms – per the CDC guidelines, people with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear **2-14 days after exposure to the virus**. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fever (at or above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit)
 - Chills
 - Muscle pain
 - Sore throat
 - New loss of taste or smell

*Note: This list is not all possible symptoms. Other less common symptoms have been reported, including gastrointestinal symptoms like nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.

WHILE inside LOKC buildings:

- Masks or Face Coverings are always required while inside our building
- Always maintain 6 feet of social distance from other persons
- Wash and sanitize hands frequently
- Avoid touching common surfaces as much as possible

While attending a performance, any person who develops a fever at or above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or who is experiencing coughing or shortness of breath should exit the building and return home or seek medical attention as appropriate.
